Maths Pig's Challenge

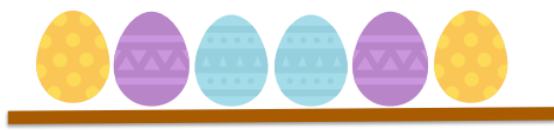
Remember our Gamlingay Village Primary mantra – Maths is for everyone!
