

# Relationships and Sex Education - Year 2



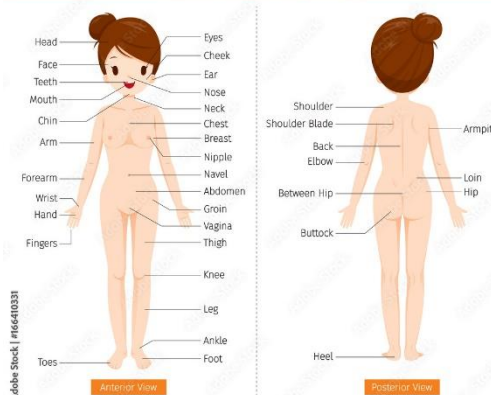
## Key vocabulary

<b>Human life cycle</b>	It has six main stages: foetus, baby, child, adolescent, adult, elderly.
<b>Pregnancy</b>	A woman carrying a baby inside her belly.
<b>Babies/child's needs</b>	An environment and relationships that support a child's emotional and physical needs to grow successfully.
<b>Responsibility</b>	Being accountable for something.
<b>Families</b>	A group of people who love each other.

<b>Prior</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• be able to recognise names for the main external parts of the body.</li> <li>• be able to name the sexual parts with growing confidence using colloquial and usually scientific words with trusted adults.</li> <li>• be able to describe what their bodies can do and understand how amazing their body is.</li> <li>• show some understanding that their body belongs to them.</li> <li>• be able to describe some basic personal hygiene routines and</li> <li>• understand how these can prevent the spread of disease.</li> </ul>
<b>Current and suggested progression</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• be able to recognise babies, children and adults of different ages and put them into age order.</li> <li>• understand that human babies grow inside their mothers.</li> <li>• be able to describe the main physical developments which take place in early childhood.</li> <li>• be able to describe some of the changes in responsibilities and expectations during early childhood.</li> <li>• understand a baby's basic needs.</li> <li>• understand how dependent a baby is on parents/carers to provide its basic needs.</li> </ul>
